Action *

FEET.

The board has received enquiries about the location of the FEET cars and access for members at the other end of the village.

Options were discussed including security issues, duplicate keys, being able to use car of choice, etc.

It was agreed, as a temporary measure, until membership numbers grow and a central point is needed for management, that FDT will move forward with the plan to locate a car down near the church. *KM to speak to residents who raised the question.

DVD.

The interest in the DVD 'Wind of Change' has been remarkable. Requests for copies are coming in thick and fast.

The online launch will be taking place at the end of this month on you tube which will allow us to track number of hits, and MSPs will all be receiving a copy for use in their constituencies.

Community organisations can receive a free copy of the DVD, however, directors agreed to ask for a donation from any commercial groups who request a copy. *KM to look at copyright and the use of material and content. *DH write draft for cover letter to send out with DVD and circulate for comment by e mail.

Due to demand, FDT directors agreed to order further copies of DVD. *KM to organise.

AGM

Directors agreed with this in principle but would also like to look at some minor changes to next years criteria for the grant given what we have learned from this year. Board discussed the proposal and the need to engage other parties interested in this project to manage it with back up assistance from FDT.
