



Fintry Development Trust has developed grant programs which aim to support and meet the Trusts' aims and objectives of reducing carbon and energy use.

The grants, while helping residents meet the costs of improving the energy efficiency and comfort of their homes also have their core roots in improving the village's sustainability.

The funds for the grants come entirely from the income generated from our share agreement in the Earlsburn Windfarm.



### Energy Efficiency Grant

The Energy Efficiency Grant is provided to help householders in the Fintry area pay for improvements to their homes that will result in energy and carbon savings. The maximum value for the grant is **£1,000** (per household, per funding round) and houses must be in the Fintry Community Council area. There is a ringfenced sum available for this grant and so they are available on a 'first-come, first-served' basis (by date for each application which meets the criteria). This round of the grant continues until 31 March 2027.



### Renewables Assistance Grant

This grant of up to **£5000** has been designed to assist households looking to convert their home energy system from fossil fuels to a renewable, green system (e.g. ASHP/GSHP/Solar). There is up to £5000 available for this grant (per household, per funding round) and up to 10 grants available on a 'first-come, first-served' basis (by date for each application which meets the criteria). This round of the grant continues until 31 March 2027.



## Emergency Discretionary Renewables Fund

This grant is intended to support those who have reached a crisis point with their renewable energy system, and whose circumstances require urgent assistance to provide a functioning renewable energy system. The amount of funding available is assessed and agreed on a case-by-case basis by the FDT Board. # GRANT PROCESS



## APPLICATION

STEP

# 01

Send us your completed grant application form PLUS the applicable quote(s). These can be sent by email or posted into our letterbox in the Sports Centre.



## REVIEW

STEP

# 02

FDT will review your application and may ask for further information or clarification.



## DECISION

STEP

# 03

You will be contacted by email with the outcome of your application.



## PAYMENT

STEP

# 04

If your application is approved, the agreed funds will be paid to you by bank transfer. Once you confirm that payment has been received, we will delete your bank details.



## EVIDENCE

# 05

On completion of your project, you MUST send us 3 photos of your grant project and a copy of the final invoice/receipts. No other grants can be applied for until this step is complete.
